# FIRST YEAR 2021

The Cape Town School of Supernatural Ministry was launched in Cape Town in 2014 as a BSSM school plant. Over the years we have planted several campuses in the Western Cape. In 2021 we will offer the First Year Course online; as well as at our Bellville and Mowbray campus. CSSM First Year is a 9 month course from 2 March 2021 to 30 November 2021.

## Explanation of First Year 2021 at our campuses

### Launch of CSSM 2021 campuses

- CSSM commences on Tuesday the 2nd of March 2021 at 7pm at our Bellville campus. Students who will attend the Mowbray campus, will also meet at the Bellville campus for opening night.
- The first two school nights are FREE (this includes the launch night) and visitors are WELCOME. This is also a good opportunity to see what our school is all about.

### Explanation of School Activities 2021

CSSM 2021 at Bellville and Mowbray campus will be from Tuesday 2 March 2021 until 30 November 2021. Below is a description of all the activities that students will be engaged with during 2021:

## Face-to-face Sessions

- Students meet every Tuesday night @ 7pm – 10pm SAST (mostly at their respective campuses). We follow the term schedule of the South African Education Department and we will try and close the school according to the SA school calendar. Due to COVID restrictions and changes, this might not be fully possible in 2021.
- During the face-to-face sessions, students either engage with live lectures (by esteemed ministers of the gospel) or watch video teaching sessions from the Bethel School of Supernatural Ministry. During school nights we also spend time in worship, share testimonies and meet in small groups. The purpose of the small groups are to reflect, practically apply what was learned and to review/ discuss new insights.
- Due to unexpected Covid Lockdown changes in South Africa, the full CSSM Calendar will only be available from the 14th of February 2021 at [www.cssm.co.za](http://www.cssm.co.za)
- The **Bellville campus** is at Journey of Grace, 102 Santyger Building, Willie van Schoor Avenue, Bellville. The **Mowbray campus** is at Gangstar Cafe, 65 Main Road, Mowbray.

## Online BSSMequip platform

- When students register for CSSM, they will gain access to the **Online BSSMequip platform**. This platform contains all the teachings (and more) that will be watched in First Year 2021. Students can access this platform via internet on a PC or laptop, or as an app that they can download on their phone. Once students have registered for the course, they will receive the details for this platform.
- Students are required to watch about 2 to 3 hours of monthly teaching on this platform. These are additional teachings and it is not watched and discussed on Tuesday nights.

## Book Reading

- Reading is a large part of our curriculum. Students will read five books in 2021 and complete book reports for each book. To complete the required reading, students are expected to read at least 1.5 hours each week.
- CSSM First Year 2021 Reading List is:
  - When Heaven Invades Earth by Bill Johnson
  - Translating God by Shawn Boltz
  - Supernatural Ways of Royalty by Kris Vallotton
  - Keep Your Love On by Danny Silk
  - The Happy Intercessor by Beni Johnson
- You can purchase these books as a set Book Package from CSSM at R1500 (excluding postage). All these books are also available in ebook format on platforms like Amazon or of that of the author.

## Homework

- Homework at CSSM is focused on personal transformation. The aim of homework is to give students opportunity to reflect on what they have learned and to internalise the concepts and revival culture taught at school.
- Homework is also an opportunity for the hungry heart, soul and mind to be satisfied by the wisdom of God and to be filled with the Holy Spirit. While there are no grades given, participation, excellence, and timely completion of homework is expected of each student.
- Homework for 2021 includes book reading, writing of book reports and completing tasks.

## Outreaches and Activations

- Students will attend 6 Saturday Activations/Outreaches per school year. See the School Calendar for these dates (please note the school calendar will only be available from the 14th of February at [www.cssm.co.za](http://www.cssm.co.za)).
- During the zoom or hub meeting, students will practise what they have learned during face-to-face classes. Students might also receive some additional teaching to support the kind of outreach they will be attending.
- Besides Saturday outreaches, students will be encouraged to participate in outreaches at their church or with other organisations/ministries in their community.

## What are the requirements for this course?

- Access to a minimum of 2 GB of data a month
- Access to a smart phone and preferably a laptop or PC also
- Access to an active email address
- Weekly teachings on Tuesday nights @ 7pm - 10pm
- 6 Saturday morning meetings that include teaching, activations and outreaches
- Watch/listen to weekly teachings (approximately 2 - 3 hours monthly)
- Reading of books: 1.5 hours (approximate every week)
- Homework: 30 minutes (approximate every week)

## What is the Course Content?

The first year programme is designed to create an environment where students can safely take risks as they learn and develop a lifestyle of character and supernatural ministry. Our courses focus on:

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- **Identity:** These courses teach students about their identity as sons and daughters and the expression, responsibility, and authority of their identity.
- **Intimacy:** These courses teach students about the power of their personal relationship with the Trinity and the spiritual practices that form and strengthen that relationship.
- **Kingdom Culture:** These courses teach students about the characteristics and nature of the kingdom and how to cultivate kingdom culture in different spheres
- **Supernatural Living:** These courses teach students how to live supernaturally and how to grow in spiritual gifts and practices such as healing, prophecy, evangelism, intercession, deliverance, prayer ministry, and more.
- **Relationship:** These courses teach students about how to steward their heart and emotions and give them tools for communication and feedback in order to cultivate healthy relationships and community.
- **Inner Healing and Deliverance:** These courses teach students how to step into and walk in Christ's freedom.

## How much does the course cost?

- Application Fee: R495
- Tuition: R3950
- Early Bird Special of R3700 if payment is made by 28 February 2021.
