History of CSSM

CSSM was launched in Cape Town in 2014 by two graduates of the Bethel School of Supernatural Ministry (Redding, California). Our school is a BSSM school plant and we make use of the BSSM curriculum. Over the years we have hosted various leaders and speakers from Bethel Church including Danny Silk, Kevin Dedmon, Paul Manwaring, Steve Backlund, Theresa Dedmon, Chuck Parry and others as well as various Bethel teams and Bethel missions teams. Locally, we have had a number of revival leaders teaching at the school. These include Bill and Connie Bennot, Nigel and Debbie Desmond, Denise Padayachee, Esme Schmitt, Lauren Bluck, Shirley Momberg and Carol Campbell. Speakers and authors who form a big part of our core curriculum include Bill Johnson, Kris Vallotton and Danny Silk.

Each year CSSM has been marked by increase and momentum. We have been privileged to have students from over 100 churches in our region get set ablaze in the reality of their God given identity, taking radical risks and seeing healing, miracles and transformation as they step into all that Jesus made available for them. 2023 will see our tenth intake of 1st year students and sixth intake of 2nd year students.

Students will learn how to read, understand, and "do" the Bible - how to practice His presence, witness, heal the sick, prophesy, preach, pray and much more.

Leadership Structure

Our CSSM leadership team consists of dynamic leaders and revivalists who truly lay down their time and resources for this school. They passionately love God and want to see lives transformed by His Presence.

Each year CSSM financial records are audited and every month our financials are represented to the financial oversight team. At CSSM, we believe in faith, radical generosity and accountability. We therefore value Journey of Grace's unfailing support in our mission to raise revivalists in Africa.

Launch of CSSM Second Year2023

What you need to know about CSSM Second Year 2023

Second Year Activities

Your time at CSSM will consist of the following:

Face to Face sessions

During the face-to-face sessions students either engage with live lectures or watch teaching sessions from the Bethel School of Supernatural Ministry. During school nights we also spend time in worship, share testimonies and meet in small groups. The purpose of the small groups are to reflect, practically apply what was learned and to review/discuss new insights.

Online BSSMequip platform

All CSSM students have access to their own account, on the online platform called BSSMequip. All the compulsory weekly teachings are loaded onto each student's account. Students can access this platform via the internet on a PC or laptop, or as an app that they can download on their phone or tablet. Once students have registered for Second Year 2023, they will receive their NEW login details for this platform.

Saturday Sessions

Students will attend 5 Saturday sessions per school year.

Practical Requirements for Second Year

To successfully participate in Second Year 2022, students need to:

- Have access to a minimum of 8GB of data per month
- Have access to a laptop or PC and/or smartphone
- Have an active email address
- Access to Zoom

Approximate Time Requirements

- Attend bi-weekly face-to-face meetings during term
- Complete one online teaching per week during term
- Work through one assignment every six weeks
- Attend five Saturday Sessions and one Weekend Conference during the year
- Complete six Faith Risk Challenges over the course of the year

Second Year Course Content

In your First Year, CSSM laid a foundation of spiritual identity, supernatural living and the healing power of God in your life, both emotionally and physically. In a nutshell, you learnt who you are, the benefits of your salvation and that God speaks to you.

What God revealed and imparted in First Year, we take to another level in Second Year.

You will learn what it means to be raised up with Him and seated in heavenly realms, how to operate as a citizen of heaven, and releasing heaven's graces and administrations on earth.

Teaching topics include:

- Intermediate prophetic training
- Strengthening your personal relationships with the trinity and the spiritual practises that form and strengthen that relationship

- Supernatural living: worship, healing, evangelism, deliverance and prayer ministry
